LThe University of Dschang is among the eight States' universities of Cameroon. Created during the University reform by decree N°93/029 of January 19, 1993, it emerged from the ashes of the former University Centre of Dschang whose principal vocation was essentially based on sylvo-pastoral and agro-pastoral activities.

Today, 08 establishments are functioning effectively: The Faculty of Letters and Social Sciences, the Faculty of Economics and Management Sciences, the Faculty of Law and Political Science, the Faculty of Science, the Faculty of Agronomy and Agricultural Sciences, the Fotso Victor University Institute of Technology, Bandjoun, the Institute of Fine Arts of Fouban , and Faculty of Medicine and Pharmaceutical Sciences

It is the only university spread over the national territory, notably, in six of the ten administrative regions of the country and whose main campus is located in a Divisional Headquarter.

As a bilingual institution of higher learning, it serves as a laboratory of diversity and the bed-rock of sustainable development. It is rated in many rankings such as the webometrics ranking, as the first university of Cameroon and of Central Africa.

The Dschang University Friends' Club
